

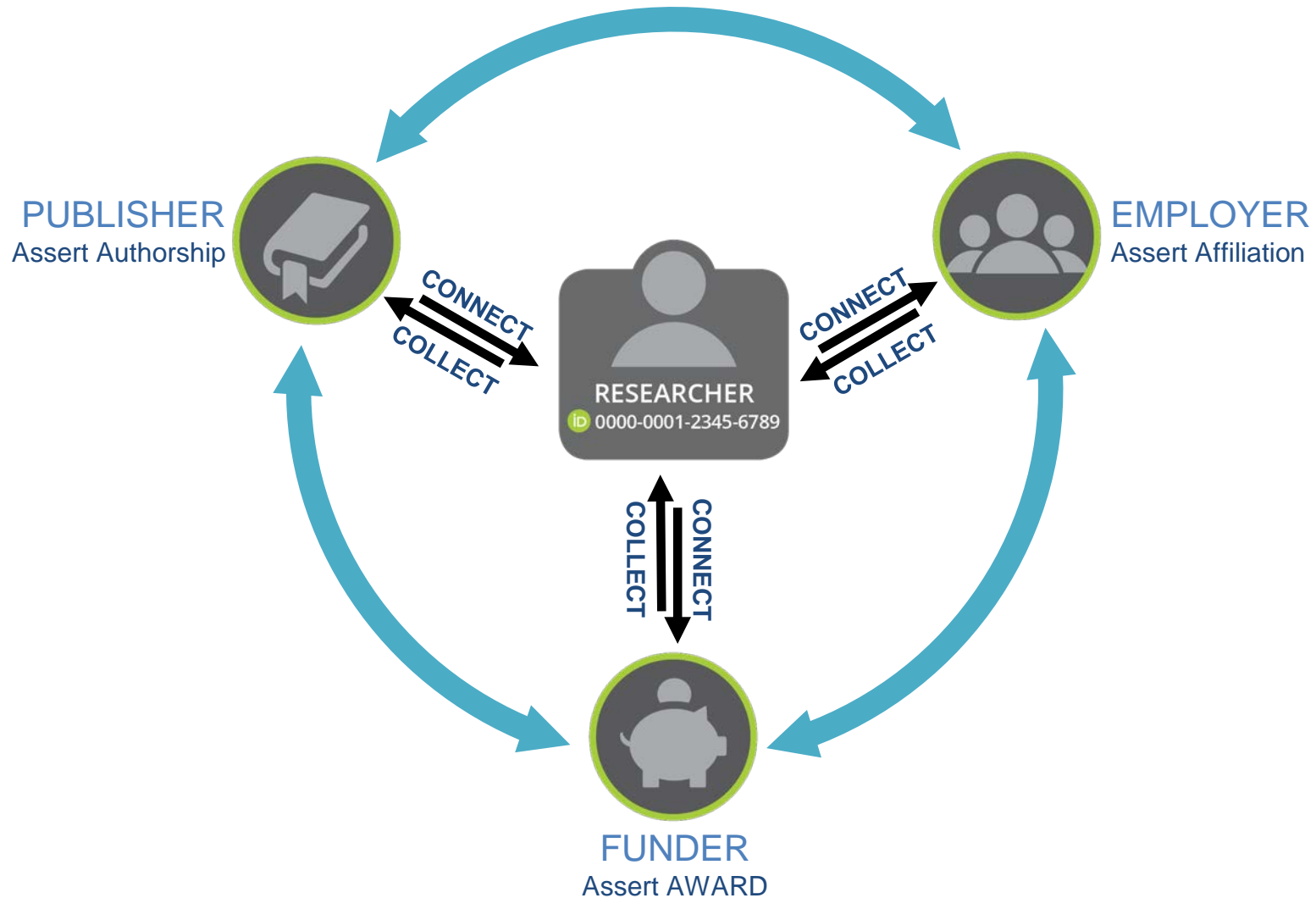

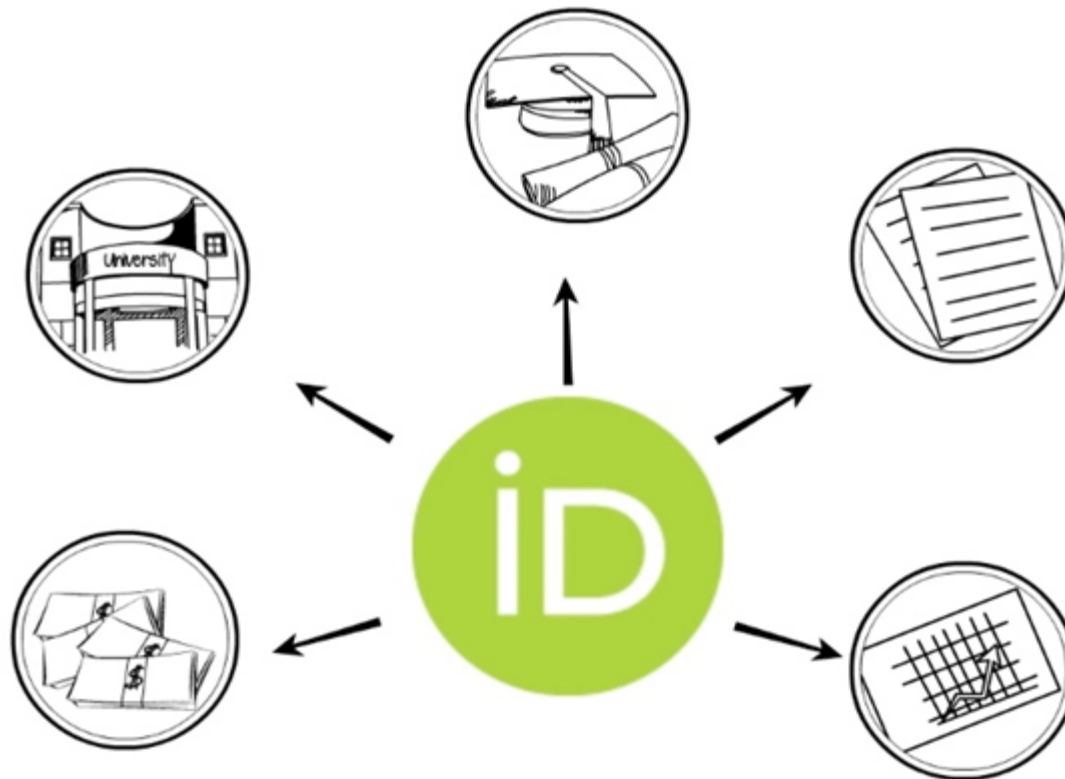

### Biography

Jo graduated with a MSc (Hons I) in Plant Science from the University of Auckland in 2000. She worked as a Research Technician at the PostHarvest Division of HortResearch for three years before starting her PhD in Plant Molecular Biology at the University of Auckland in collaboration with HortResearch. Her research project investigated genetic and hormonal controls of vegetative branching in petunia. After completing her PhD she took up a post-doctoral position in Forensic Biology at the Institute of Environmental Science and Research (ESR) Ltd. in 2007. Jo joined Libraries and Learning Services at the University of Auckland in 2014, and took up her current position as Subject Librarian for the School of Environment in September 2015.


Her research project for her Master of Information Studies investigated the barriers to sharing research data in tertiary institutions and how the perspectives of researchers and information professionals differ.

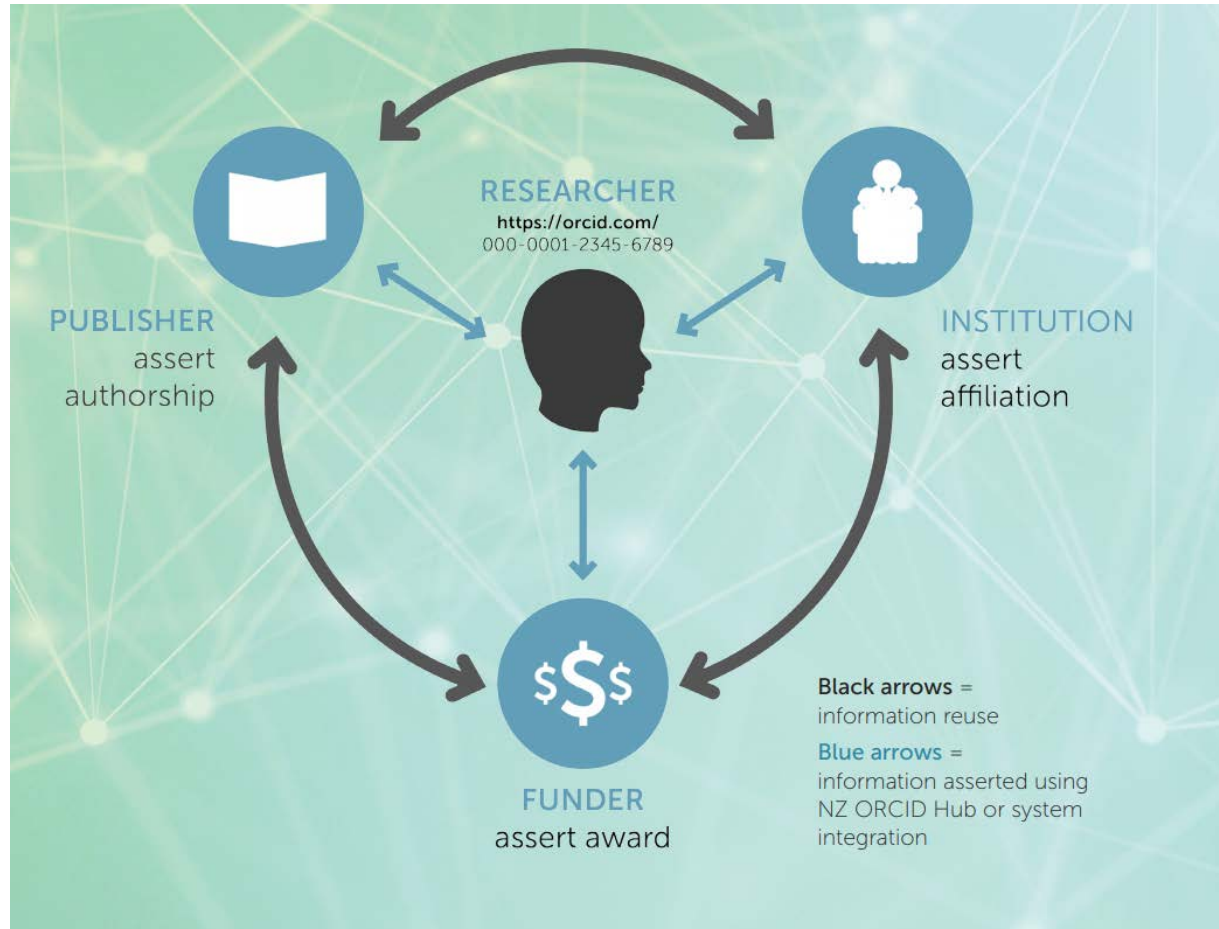
