



Benefits and limitations

LIMITATIONS
Unregulated: could be manipulated or gamed
Reliability : may indicate popularity with the general public rather than quality research
Acceptance: Many funders and institutions use
traditional metrics to measure research impact
Context: use of online tools may differ by
discipline, geographic region, and over time.
